Awards will be given in various categories such as: Best Band, Best Antique Car, Best Military Display, Best Float, Best Overall Entry, Best Farm Equipment, etc. Please note that awards will be presented at the stage in Branch Junction 30 minutes after the conclusion of the parade.

## **IMPORTANT PARADE INFORMATION FOR 2017**

- ✓ **Please keep a reasonable distance between your entry and the entry that you are following. Not too close, but definitely not too far away. Gaps should be kept to a minimum.**
- ✓ You will be crossing the railrode tracks during the route and I ask that you proceed with caution.
- ✓ **No parade entries will be allowed to throw out candy.** This decision was made due to several instances where children were almost injured running out to get candy during the parade. You are more than welcome to have someone from your group walk along the sides of the road and pass out candy to the kids watching the parade.
- ✓ If you are driving a car, golf cart, four wheeler, motorcycle, or other motorized vehicle in the parade, we ask that you please refrain from “performing” with your vehicle during the parade. This includes squealing tires, doing wheelies, driving quickly, etc. We ask this for the safety of the children and adults watching the parade. The only exception to this rule is the Shrine, Omar, and Jamil groups with the small cars (go carts) that perform in parades on a regular basis because they have been trained to do so.
- ✓ Horses will be allowed in the parade. All riders must be willing to provide cleanup. If you choose to join in the parade, you **MUST** provide cleanup for your horse.
- ✓ **A CURRENT (12MONTH) NEGATIVE COGGINS CERTIFICATE IS REQUIRED AND MUST BE SHOWN THE DAY OF THE PARADE.**
